

South County Emergency Siren Warning Policy



Listed below is a summary of the South County Emergency Siren Policy:

- The South County Fire Authority is responsible for activation of emergency sirens.
- The siren may or may not be activated for severe weather storms. For instance, if there is a severe thunder storm to the north or south of Schoolcraft, and SKFA does not believe that the storm will pass through the Village of Schoolcraft, the siren will not be activated.
- The siren will **always** be activated for tornado warnings.
- The siren consists of thee blasts – three minutes on – three minutes off. The blasts will continue until the tornado has passed.
- There will be **no** “all clear” warning.
- The warning system in the Fire Station will be activated in addition to the rotating siren.
